



Douglas Companies Scanner Options

Opticon 1003, 1004: Fee= \$5.50/week (Mobi)

This scanner is used to send information over the telephone line. The scanner sits in the cradle with the scanner sensor sitting on the cradle sensor to communicate and transmit information.



Opticon 9728: Fee= \$4.00/week (Opti)

This scanner sends information through the internet at our Douglas website. The scanner sits in the cradle, which is connected to the customer's computer. The customer then goes online and sends the order.



CipherLab 8200: Fee= \$5.50/week (Mobi)

This scanner can send information through either the phone line, or through the computer depending on which version you have. There is an optional trigger that attaches to the back of this scanner with a making it easier to carry with you and scan items.



MobiAir: Fee/week: \$1.50 app only, \$3.50 with scanner, \$5.50 with iPad

The MobiAir application is available for both Apple (iPhone and iPad), and for Android phone operating systems. This sends information through the customer's cellular data, or through their Wi-Fi if the customer is on a wireless network. (Although the data amount is almost completely unnoticeable with an average of around 150KB/Week.)

The device uses a Bluetooth connection to work with a small scanner in order to create customer orders, however you can choose to use the application only, and type your item numbers in the application instead. The iPad mini comes with a protective case, and is set up and ready to use.
